Koko the Gorilla

- Koko was a famous gorilla that had been taught to use sign language since the age of one. She had a word bank of over 1,000 signs. Her conversations with humans consisted of three to six words. One day, with her ability to communicate using signs, she requested a kitten from her trainers. Some trainers believe it may have been because Koko's favorite story was "Three Little Kittens."
- Koko's request was granted, and she chose a tailless, gray male kitten. One trainer wondered if Koko made this choice because, like a gorilla, the kitten had no tail. Koko enjoyed the kitten's company. She named the kitten All Ball and treated it like a baby gorilla. She even carried it on her back! Koko was observed using sign language to suggest to All Ball that they tickle each other. Tickling was Koko's favorite game. Koko and All Ball enjoyed a special bond. This became evident when Koko was once seen dressing All Ball in napkins and All Ball did not put up a fight!

A Great Team

- The emperor penguin is one of seventeen different kinds of penguins. The largest of all the penguins, these <u>flightless</u> birds live in Antarctica.

In March and April, they make their way to the breeding sites. Emperor penguins do not build nests. Instead, they stand and huddle together to keep warm.
- With winter approaching, the female lays a single egg. After the egg is laid, the female passes it to her mate and goes off to the open sea for about two months to find food for herself. The male keeps the egg warm by balancing it on his feet and covering it with his feathered skin. If the chick hatches before the mother returns, the male feeds the chick a milk-like substance produced by an organ located below the esophagus.
- When the mother returns, she will have eaten enough to feed herself and the chick. The male then goes off to eat. The mother brings up from her stomach some of the food she had stored to feed the chick from her mouth. After several weeks, the male returns to his post to help care for the chick. He feeds the chick the same way the female does. By December or January, the young penguin is old enough to take care of itself.
